Character Trait: Friendship

CHARACTER TRAIT: Each month our Bullpups will be learning about a character trait. For the month of September, the character trait is "Friendship". Ask your child what they have done to be a good friend.

SCHOOL BREAKFAST AND LUNCH: Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. Our students need to be properly "fueled up" to learn. Did you know that SES serves breakfast every day from 8:00 to 8:25 a.m.? Each day your child can choose a hot choice (breakfast burrito, French toast sticks, pancakes, etc.) or cereal and a muffin. Juice, fruit and milk are also available. Please consider adding a little extra money to your child's meal account and encourage them to eat breakfast at school. The regular price for breakfast is \$2.30. If your family qualifies for reduced/free lunch then breakfast is free too! Walkers and students who are dropped off - the door is open at 8:00 a.m. for breakfast. Please make sure you always have money in their meal account. Lunches are \$2.90 and milk is .60. NO charging permitted.

PARENTS ONLY—FOR SAFETY'S SAKE: The only person who may write a note or call for a child to change after school plans is the guardian. If your child is being picked up by someone other than yourself, it is you (the guardian) that we need to hear from. It is best that we receive this information in the morning ... so that we may send a "student message" AND to get further information if needed. Please feel free to use the 24 hr. SAFE ARRIVAL line 427-7457 for absences. THANKS!

DISMISSAL TIME: Our classroom teachers instruct students until dismissal time 3:20. The last portion of the day is used to review what was learned, to "set the stage" for the next day, to practice a skill just introduced, or to introduce homework. When a child is picked up "just a few minutes early", the teacher must take a few minutes to help that child prepare to leave AND that child misses instruction. PLEASE save picking your child up "just a few minutes early" for appointments or emergencies. If an early pick up is just for your convenience, please consider allowing your child to finish the day with the rest of the students. For student safety and timeliness, students may not get off the bus once they have boarded.

VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS: ALL visitors and volunteers please stop at the office to sign in and pick up a badge to wear while you are in the building. Volunteers need to have completed a Washington State Background check before volunteering. Forms are in the office.


CROSSWALK: Please use the crosswalks when dropping off and picking up students instilling good modeling and safety for all.

BUS LANE: Just a reminder that in the morning the "red lane" is for buses and drop off only, absolutely NO PARKING or waiting. Buses need to unload, load and leave as soon as possible. The "yellow lane" is for drop off only, absolutely NO PARKING. If you are waiting for a bus, please use the parking lot. Thank you for your help with this.

ATTENDANCE: There may be completely acceptable reasons for your child's missed days or tardiness. Parents and guardians play a major role in their child's attendance. An adult's attitude, support, expectations, and actions will assist in getting your child to school each and every day, on time. A student who arrives even a few minutes late ends up playing "catch up" for most of the morning. That child's day can end up being very stressful and frustrating which impacts learning. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

- Set a regular bedtime, and stick to it.
- Prepare clothes the night before, lay them out.
- I Finish homework in the evening; put the backpack by the door.
- Set an alarm clock, or even two.
- Plan to have your child IN THE CLASSROOM by 8:25 a.m.
- 🛘 Schedule your child's appointments after 3:30 p.m. or on early release days whenever possible.

COUNSELING CORNER: I am so happy to be back at SES for the second year. Last year was such a great year and I know that this year will be too. This year, it is my intention to teach students different ways to regulate their emotions. One of the best ways to do that is through breathing. While I teach students different ways of breathing, one of my favorites is Take 5 Breathing. Here are the instructions so you can practice at home with your child. 1. Stretch your hand out like a star. 2. Get the pointer finger of your other hand ready to trace your fingers up and down. 3. Slide up each finger slowly ~ slide down the other side. 4. Breath in through your nose ~ out through your mouth. 5. Put it together and breathe in as you slide up and breathe out as you slide down. Keep going until you have finished tracing your hand.
